Dr. Álvarez García is an Associate Professor in the academic area of Developmental and Educational Psychology at the University of Oviedo (Spain). He currently teaches in the Primary School Education Degree and in the Secondary Education Teaching Master's Degree. Member of the Aprendizaje Escolar, Dificultades y Rendimiento Académico [School Learning, Difficulties and Academic Performance] (ADIR) research group at the University of Oviedo. He has participated in research projects such as “Analysis of interpersonal relationships in the educational centers of Asturias”, “Risk factors associated with cybervictimization in adolescence”, and “The training of pre-service teachers to deal with school violence”. Co-author of school violence assessment tools, such as CUVE3 questionnaires (Ed. Albor-Cohs, 2012), and the Aprende a

Resolver Conflictos [Learn to Solve Conflicts] (ARCO) intervention program (Ed. CEPE, 2007). In the last five years he has published research papers about school violence in journals such as *Aggression and Violent Behavior*, *Anales de Psicología*, *Educación XX1*, *International Journal of Clinical and Health Psychology*, *Infancia y Aprendizaje*, *Psicothema*, and *Revista de Psicodidáctica*.
